

Protocols for working with Projet Jeune Leader

- Perdiem The Association/NGO agrees to pay <u>each</u> of Projet Jeune Leader trainers:
 - 40,000 AR per day of work (including travel days) if the training is held outside of Fianarantsoa
 - 15,000 AR per day of work *if* the training is held in Fianarantsoa Projet Jeune Leader will send at least 2 trainers regardless of the group size.
- b. Housing If the training will take place outside of Fianarantsoa, the Association/NGO agrees to pay for the trainers' lodging. If the trainers are of same gender, please book 2 separate rooms. If the trainers are of the same gender, they can share a room but please book a room with 2 beds. If the training will take place in a rural area with no hotels, then please arrange other lodging and communicate a week in advance if the trainers need to bring additional equipment (pillows, blankets, flashlight, etc.).
- c. Transport The Association/NGO agrees to pay for the roundtrip transport for each trainer from Fianarantsoa to the training site. If the training will take place outside of Fianarantsoa, please cover the transport <u>all the way</u> to the training site/hotel (this might include an additional taxi or pousse-pousse fare). Projet Jeune Leader will advance the funds for the trainers to travel <u>to</u> the training site and will bring the receipts to the training for reimbursement.
- d. Materials The Association/NGO agrees to contribute a lump sum of 60,000 AR for training materials (Note: if the number of participants exceeds 25, or if you are requesting a training for more than 2 days, Projet Jeune Leader will adjust this amount). Projet Jeune Leader will advance these funds to buy materials and will bring the receipts to the training for reimbursement.
